## PHEV 2007 Conference - "Where the Grid Meets the Road"

### May 30, 2007

Manitoba Hydro, along with the University of Manitoba, Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada, the University of Winnipeg - Center for Sustainable Transportation, and the Province of Manitoba will be hosting a Conference on Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicles **PHEV 2007 - Where the Grid Meets the Road**, on November 1 and 2, 2007 at the Hotel Delta Winnipeg.

This Conference is expected to attract over 200 attendees and will focus on opportunities and challenges that Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicles (PHEVs) present for sustainable transportation. It will provide collaboration amongst industry, academia, utilities, and government to understand how PHEV technologies integrate into current and future transportation systems and the electrical power grid.
